KINDERGARTEN GATHERING

We are excited to invite you to our spring Kindergarten Gathering! We have two options for families to attend the Kindergarten Gathering.

In-Person Option:

The in-person Kindergarten Gathering event will be held on Thursday, May 13th. Each student and ONE family member will sign-up for a 20 minute slot between 4:00-5:30. At the gathering event, your Kindergartner will meet a kindergarten teacher, get to see a kindergarten classroom, go on a school tour, and learn more about kindergarten!

To ensure social distancing and safety measures, only your Kindergartner and ONE family member will be able to attend the in-person option. The in-person option will be conducted in groups of up to 5 Kindergartners, 5 family members, and one staff member (total group size approximately 11).

Masks must be worn at all times.

Please self-screen at home prior to the event and stay home if any symptoms are noted.

Drive-through Option:

The drive-through Kindergarten Gathering event will take place on Thursday, May 13th from 5:40-6:00. Families will stay in their car and drive up to the Otter Lake front doors where a staff member will greet you and give you a bag of Kindergarten "goodies" to get your child excited about Kindergarten!

However, if you are uninsured, underinsured, have a high deductible or co-pay amount that you are not able to pay, grant funds can help cover these costs through the Department of Human Services, the Suburban Ramsey Family Collaborative and the Ramsey County Children's Mental Health Collaborative.
