#### **MCA**

Dear White Bear In-Person Learning families,

The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) annually administers statewide assessments. They are designed to provide the state, districts, and schools with a snapshot of student progress towards meeting the Minnesota K-12 Academic Standards. This spring we will be administering the MCA/MTAS assessments throughout the month of April and part of May in accordance with state and federal requirements. There is no remote option for these assessments. Students who are in-person learning will be scheduled to take the assessments as part of the regular school day. Third, fourth, and fifth grade Otter Lake students will be taking the reading and math MCAs on April 27, April 28, May 4, and May 5. Fifth grade students will take the science MCAs on May 11.

MDE is aware of the concerns about the impact of the pandemic on learning, and is expecting student results to look different from previous years. When the assessment is administered correctly, the scores will still represent an accurate snapshot of student learning of the grade-level content standards. The district also uses the results as an additional measure to evaluate our curriculum.

The school district will be following all applicable COVID-19 health and safety guidelines for testing.
