Hello Otter Lake Families!

Welcome to the new school year! School and classroom routines are established (or close to it) and strong relationships have been formed. These relationships and routines are vital to a successful learning environment for all students! Thank you for all you have done to support a successful start to the school year!

Here are some highlights of things we are working on the first couple of months of the school year:

- Be a Bear! your child may come home and say "I was a bear at school today!" This means they were being respectful, responsible, and ready. Each classroom has defined what this means within their classroom and as a school we defined what this means in our common areas. Students learned that being a bear means they can be a bear EVERYWHERE! Being a bear is how we do our work in and outside of school...adults included!
- Social and Emotional Learning At Otter Lake, the social and emotional experiences are as important as the academic experiences we provide for students. We use proactive and reactive strategies to help students develop self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationships skills, and responsible decision-making skills. Each day, students and teachers engage in focused social and emotional lessons from 7:45-8:00. We also have building-wide themes for social and emotional learning. Keep an eye out for family "home links" that will be sent home with students. These homework activities are designed to support families with reinforcing the social and emotional skills students are learning at Otter Lake.

White Bear Area Food Shelf

The White Bear Area Food Shelf KidPack Program is a free, optional, supplemental weekend food program for Kindergarten to Fifth Grade Students. Enrolled Students will receive a bag of single-serve food items (including 2 breakfast, 4 lunches, and a handful of snack items) on the last day of the school week to bring home for the weekend. Common items include granola bars, applesauce cups, macaroni and cheese, cereal bowls, and meal kits. We ask that parents or guardians inform their children of food preparation safety practices and check all provided food before consumption.

Fundraiser Pick Up for ship to school items is at OLE on Monday, November 15th, from 2:30 - 6:00pm.


